

Dr. Lucija Sokanović, Assist. Prof. was born on August 6, 1977 in Zadar. She graduated from the Faculty of Law in Split in 2000 and received her PhD in 2014 at the Faculty of Law in Zagreb with the thesis of "Fraud in Criminal Law" under the mentorship of Prof. Dr. Davor Derenčinović. She was awarded the Dean Award for outstanding success in the study. She passed the Bar Exam in 2002. From 2000 to 2004 she worked as a Judicial Trainee and a Judicial Advisor at the Municipal Court in Kaštel Lukšić and the Commercial Court in Split. Since 2004 he has been employed as a research fellow, assistant, senior assistant and docent at the Faculty of Law - University of Split. She participates in conducting classes in Criminal Law, Economic Criminal Law, Environmental Criminal Law, Sports Criminal Law, and Economic Crime. She has been professionally trained at the Max Planck Institute for Foreign and International Criminal Law in Freiburg and the Freie Universität in Berlin, the International Institute of Higher Studies in Criminal Sciences in Syracuse, The Royal Netherlands Academy of Arts and Science in Amsterdam. She is also author and co-author of scientific papers in Croatian, English, and German in the field of Criminal law and has lectured at domestic and international scientific conferences in the Republic of Croatia and abroad. In addition to the Faculty of Law, she also teaches at the Forensic Department for University Studies at the University of Split. She is researcher at the projects: CROATIAN VIOLENCE MONITOR, A Study of Phenomenology, Etiology and Prosecution of Delinquent Violence with Focus on Protecting Particularly Vulnerable Groups of Victims (UIP-2017-05-8876), Croatian Science Foundation and "Comparative European Study on Disenfranchisement and Restrictions of Certain Civil and Political Rights after Conviction", Aristotle University of Thessaloniki & Max Planck Institute for Foreign and International Criminal Law (2017-2020). She was a researcher in the projects of the Faculty of Law - University of Split: "Croatian borders in the Adriatic Sea and Economic Relations connected with the Sea" (2004-2007), "Great Croatian Penalist Jerolim Mičelović - Michielli "(2007-2012) and "Contemporary Developments in Criminal Legislation "(2012-2017). She is head of the Institute for Criminal and Criminological Research "Ivan Vučetić" (2014-2016, 2018-) and Director of the Center for Lifelong Education at the Faculty of Law in Split (2018-). She is one of the Directors of the Crime Prevention Criminal Law & Security Studies Course & Adriatic Moot Court Competition (2018-). She was a member of the Editorial Board of the Collected Papers of the Faculty of Law - University of Split (2014-2018). She is an associate of the Academy of Legal Sciences of Croatia (since 2019). She is a member of the Croatian Association for European Criminal Law, the Croatian Association for Criminal Science and Practice and the Max Planck Partnership Group for Balkan Criminology. She received the University Department of Forensic Science's award for the best quality teaching in 2015/16, and the Award of the Student Choir of the Faculty of Law - the University of Split in 2017.
